For the EHR reporting period in 2020: Medicare eligible hospitals and critical access hospitals (CAHs) will use the QualityNet system to submit meaningful use attestations.. The Registration and Attestation System will continue to be available for Medicaid-only eligible hospitals and CAHs. These hospitals should contact their state Medicaid agencies (PDF) for specific information on how to attest.

Providers will receive their Registration ID (NLR Registration ID) after CMS registration (Step 1b above). You cannot sign in to the Maryland Medicaid Registration site without this number.
